

Deja vu all over again

Nazareth wins 1997 national title in similar fashion to 1996

Same time. Same place. Same teams. Same ending.

Baseball Hall of Famer and quip artist Yogi Berra might have referred to it as "deja vu all over again." Even the weather -- cloudy and rainy most of the day -- was the same.

The Golden Flyers from Nazareth College won the NCAA Division III championship for the second year in a row last May 25 with a heart-stopping, gut-wrenching 15-14 overtime win over Washington College in front of 18,086 fans at Byrd Stadium in College Park, Md. No one told the Golden Flyers to rewrite the script from 1996 when Nazareth also defeated Washington in overtime, 11-10, in the title game.

Midfielder Ryan McDermott, a junior last season, was the triggerman this time as he fired a shot past Washington goalie Andy Taibl just 30 seconds into the sudden-death period. In 1996, midfielder Terry Goetz scored the game-winner just 14 seconds into the extra period.

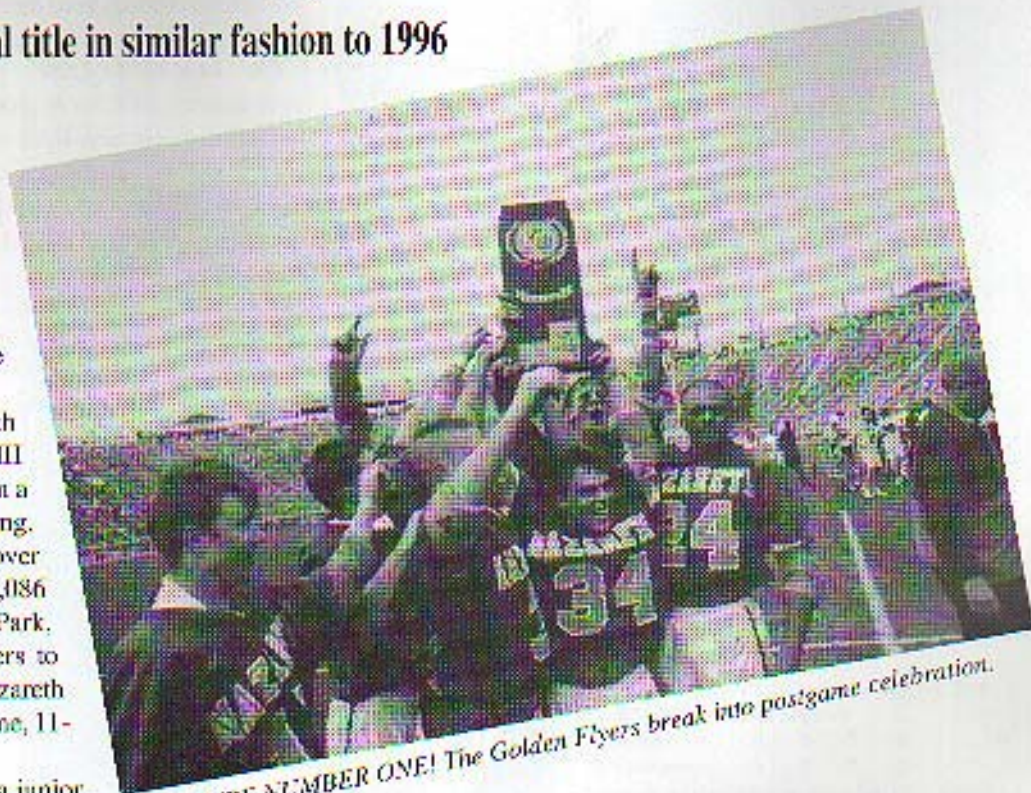
Nazareth, in winning its third national title in six years (the Golden Flyers also won the title in 1992), finished 13-3.

"It was just a terrific college lacrosse game," said Nazareth Coach Scott Nelson, who lifted his career record to 139-33, spread over 12 seasons. "It was kind of like a boxing match where two fighters go toe to toe, but neither can deliver the knockout blow."

McDermott finally delivered after being held scoreless through the first 60 minutes. Washington had controlled the overtime faceoff, but senior attackman Trent Brown made a timely defensive play as he checked the ball from the stick of Washington's George Aterbury.

Nazareth gained possession and the ball wound up in the stick of McDermott after a successful clear by junior midfielder Tim Borchert. McDermott's instinct was to pass the ball to Brent Rothfuss, the Golden Flyers' leading scorer. With Rothfuss covered, McDermott sprinted past his defender and launched the game-winning shot that landed in the upper right corner of the goal.

"Up until that point, it was probably my worst game of the year," McDermott said humbly after the dream-come-true goal. "I wasn't hitting the cage with my shots and I wasn't playing good defense. I just kept saying to myself, 'What can I do to help the team win?'"

McDermott's goal ended an epic battle. The score had been tied seven times and Nazareth had three-goal leads on three occasions, only to have Washington show its resilience by rallying.

Brown saved his best game for last as he earned game MVP honors by scoring a career-high five goals and adding two assists. What didn't show up in the post-game stats, however, was the defensive play he made to set up McDermott's goal.

"That play just epitomized the day he had," Nelson said. "He scored in just about every possible way. He scored on extra-man, he scored on a fastbreak, and he scored off a dodge. Then the defensive play he made at the end was the result of pure hustle."

Washington had leads of 3-2 after one quarter and 8-7 at halftime. The Shoremen took their first and only two-goal lead of the game early in the third quarter, but the Golden Flyers rallied to score three times (Rothfuss, Brown, and Chris Nadelen) in a 17-second span to regain the lead. After Washington scored again to tie the score at 10, Nazareth got two goals from Rothfuss and one from Brown to take a 13-10 advantage. Washington was resilient, scoring the next three goals to tie the score again.

Brown scored unassisted at 6:29 of the fourth quarter to push Nazareth back in front 14-13, but Washington's Adam Bond forced overtime with an unassisted score with 1:00 to play.

Nazareth's third championship in six years was made pos-

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sible by home playoff wins over Alfred University and Ohio Wesleyan. The 17-6 first-round triumph over Alfred (behind six goals from Rothfuss) avenged a disappointing 12-11 regular-season setback.

The 16-9 semifinal win over Ohio Wesleyan (behind four goals from Dennis Foley) marked the third year in a row that the Golden Flyers defeated OWU in the semifinals.

The title was additionally recognized by the United States Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association, which awarded Nazareth nine All-Americans.

Rothfuss was named Division III Player of the Year and Midfielder of the Year and Dan Garrett took home Defenseman of the Year honors. Defenseman Brandon Piccarreto was a first-team All-American for the second year in a row and longstick midfielder Tom Fritz also made the first team. Others honored were attackmen Brown (third team) and Joe Spada (honorable mention), midfielder McDermott (second team), defenseman Marcos Santana (second team), and goalie Jake Coon (honorable mention).
