










# 2007-08 COACHES Cross Country - Track & Field

# HEAD COACH Scott LOVE



Equipped with more than two decades of coaching experience at various levels in the Syracuse area, Scott Love joined the Nazareth athletic department as a full-time staff member in August of 2002.

In 2003, Love served as head coach of the men's and women's cross country teams as well as the indoor

and outdoor track and field teams, all of which were in their first season of intercollegiate competition.

In 2006, Love reaped some reward for his hard work and dedication in building the Nazareth programs when sophomore Nick Stenuf became Nazareth's first track and field All-American in both the indoor and outdoor 800-meter runs.

Love's teams have succeeded in the classroom as well. Both the track and field and cross country teams have been recognized for having collective grade-point averages well above 3.0. Academic achievement has always been important for Love, who also teaches classes in English Literature at Nazareth.

A graduate of Syracuse University (B.A. English, 1977; M.A. American Literature, 1982), Love coached men's and women's cross country at Onondaga Community College, where he helped produce junior college All-Americans in 1999 and 2001. He also recently has coached in the Empire State Games and served as Central Region coordinator of men's track and field for the 2000 Games that were contested in Cortland.

Love was an assistant coach for cross country and track and field at SU from 1994 through 1998 and his runners set several school records. The men's cross country team won the 1995 IC4A University Men's Team Championship as well as the University of Miami Greentree Invitational and the Western Ontario Invitational. The women's cross country team also won the Miami Greentree Invitational and earned Academic All-American team honors.

As head cross country coach at Onondaga Community College from 1998 to 2001, Coach Love's athletes earned two individual conference titles and twice earned junior college All-American honors.

As a high school coach at P.V. Moore High School in Central Square, N.Y. from 1984 to 1992, Love's teams won 16 Onondaga League divisional titles and one Section Three championship. His cross country teams posted a dual meet record of 102-6 over 12 seasons. Love also has coached at East Syracuse-Minoa, Onondaga Central, and West Genesee.

Love resides in the Syracuse suburb of Jamesville with his wife, Judy, who is employed by New York State. They are the parents of Jason and Caitlin.

### ASSISTANT COACH Jim Rolince



Nazareth graduate Jim Rolince is back for his fourth season as a part-time assistant coach for cross country and track and field.

A native of Solvay, N.Y., Rolince completed his undergraduate degree in Psychology in 2004. He's now working on a graduate degree in Literacy Education.

Before completing his degree at Nazareth,

Rolince competed on the Golden Flyers' first cross country team in the fall of 2003 and was a sprinter on the indoor and outdoor track teams in '03-04 season.

At Solvay High School, Rolince competed in football, basketball, and track and was Section Three pentathlon champion in 2000. In football, he helped Solvay to a Section Three title in 1998 and twice was honored as an Onondaga League all-star.

### ASSISTANT COACH Kristen Lempicki



Kristen Lempicki is back for her fourth season as a part-time track and field assistant. She also coaches the Golden Flyers' JV soccer team.


Lempicki was a member of both the soccer and track and field teams as a Nazareth undergraduate.

In four soccer seasons, Lempicki amassed

50 points and ranks among the Golden Flyers' all-time leaders with 18 career assists. In track and field, Lempicki holds the school record in the javelin with a heave of 30.97 meters (101 feet, 7 inches) in 2004.

Lempicki is a native of Washingtonville, N.Y. and competed scholastically in soccer, basketball and track. She won the Section Nine title in javelin in 2000.

### ASSISTANT COACH Chris Ryer



Back for his third season as a part-time assistant coach, Chris Ryer earned an array of accolades as an undergraduate at Ithaca College.

A native of Binghamton, Ryer graduated from Ithaca in 2004 with a degree in biology. As a senior in '04, Ryer won Empire 8 Conference indoor titles in the

55-meter dash and as a member of the 800-meter relay team. He also placed fourth and fifth respectively in those two events at the NYSCTC Indoor championships.

In 2001, Ryer won a state title in the 55-meter dash with a winning time of 6.6 seconds. He placed third that year in that event at the ECAC Championships and fifth in the 100-meter dash at the state outdoor championships.

Ryer attended Seton Catholic High School in Binghamton and was a Section Four all-star as a sprinter in the 100-, 200- and 400-meter dashes.

Ryer is working on his doctorate degree in physical therapy.



# Cross Country - Track & Field cross country season preview

### GOLDEN FLYERS STRONGER THAN EVER

Last season, just their fourth year as intercollegiate competitors, the Nazareth cross country teams made significant strides toward becoming an elite player in Division III. Each team placed 14th in their respective races at the NCAA Atlantic Region Championships at Letchworth State Park.

This season, with the return of a strong nucleus of experienced runners supported by an excellent freshman class and rapidly improving underclassmen, both teams look to break into the regional top 10 for the first time in the program's history.

The women return all of their top scorers from last season, including Empire 8 all-stars Jessica Brown (Oxford) and Ashley Hughes (Phoenix), both seniors. Other top performers included juniors Lauren Glaser (Huntington) and Abby Crain (Corcoran) and sophomores Jenny Lounsbury (Cicero-North Syracuse) and Shannon Bradley (Irondequoit).

In addition, senior captains Liz Pfleghardt (Tioga) and Jennifer Katz (Spencerport) and junior Amanda Gatch (Trumansburg) will look to help develop a large contingent of talented returning and new runners into a strong supporting cast.

Other returning runners include juniors
Megan Goetz (Fairport), Stephanie Hayduke
(Westhill) and Brooke Redding (RushHenrietta) and sophomores Stephanie
Johnson (Spencerport) and Caitlyn
Parmelee (Tioga).

New runners looking to contribute to the cross country program for the first time are sophomore Alison D'Angelo (Westhill), and freshmen Jacquie Brambley (Queensbury), Danielle Fiorentino (New Hartford), Samantha Hickok (Glens Falls), Megan O'Connor (Baldwinsville), Jessica Goodrich

(Solvay), Mallory Greenseich (Cicero-North Syracuse), Lizzie McAndrew (Cicero-North Syracuse), Jessica Stanchus (Greece Arcadia) and Sarah Wilcox (Rush-Henrietta).

The men's team appears to be short on depth with just 11 runners, but the Golden Flyers make up for that with talent.

Seniors Brendan Epstein (Moravia), Aaron Sirtoli (Mt. Markham) and Nick Stenuf (East Syracuse-Minoa) spearhead a solid contingent as all three gained Empire 8 Conference all-star recognition.


Others looking to break through include seniors Mike Anderson (Skaneateles) and Chris McBride (Penfield), juniors Rob Castor (East Syracuse-Minoa) and Sean Rahrle (Baldwinsville), and sophomore Chris Freeman (Rush-Henrietta).

The top newcomers are sophomore Brad Frink (Canastota) and freshmen Justin McConnell (Pulaski), and Matt Morales (Delhi).

Nazareth's women's team was honored as an Academic All-American team by the United States Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association after posting a cumulative grade-point average of 3.51.

Brown and Epstein were recognized individually with GPAs of 3.74 and 3.98 respectively. Brown placed 11th at the Empire 8 Conference meet and represented the Golden Flyers on the NCAA Division III Atlantic Region all-star team with a 30th place finish.

Epstein was honored for the second year in a row, while Stenuf, in his first year as a cross country runner, was named E8 Rookie of the Year

The Golden Flyers broke several records in 2007 and hope to challenge for several Empire 8 Conference championships in 2008.


Led by senior record-holders Jessica Brown (1,500 meters) and Ashley Hughes (5,000 meters), Nazareth's women's team will seek continued improvement.

The Athletic Department is committed to assisting in the college's mission of educating students with a goal of fostering lifelong commitment to intellectual, ethical and aesthetic values. The Athletic Department will operate under firm institutional control of the college and will always place the health and welfare of the student-athletes, coaches and staff first in decisions regarding the athletics program.

The department will operate under the NCAA Division III philosophy, through which academics are the student's first priority and sportsmanship, fair play, diversity and ethical conduct are constantly taught and promoted.

### Campus expansion

2004 marked the completion of Nazareth's largest capital campaign in history. The college raised \$25 million to support the recent campus expansion through the purchase of 73 acres of adjoining land and buildings. Today's campus features 148 acres and includes the five-story Golisano Academic Center,

the 2,200-seat Golden Flyer Stadium, the spacious Elizabeth George and Portka residence halls and a softball diamond.

Students now have twice as many classrooms and computer labs; more undergraduate and graduate programs; opportunities to compete on intercollegiate teams in equestrian, cross country, track and field, men's volleyball, and women's softball; and a choice of living options that includes suites, cafes and free laundry service.

### Enrollment

Full-time undergraduate enrollment for the fall of 2007 will be approximately 2,000. That number increases to about 3,200 with the inclusion of part-time and graduate students. There are more than 1,250 students living on campus.

The 2007-08 freshman class had an average SAT score of 1150. One quarter of incoming freshmen finished in the top 10 percent of their high school graduating class; two-thirds ranked in the top 25 percent.

Seventy-five percent of Nazareth's 26,000 alumni reside in New York state. Nearly 70 percent are employed in service professions including education, health care, child care, social work, and counseling.
