

Nazareth Cross Country Head Coach Scott Love



Equipped with more than two decades of coaching experience at various levels in the Syracuse area, Scott Love joined the Nazareth athletic department as a full-time staff member in August of 2002.

A graduate of Syracuse University (B.A. English, 1977; M.A. American Literature, 1982), Love will serve as head coach of the men’s and women’s cross country teams as well as the indoor and outdoor track and field teams, all of which begin intercollegiate competition at Nazareth this year.

Most recently, Love coached men’s and women’s cross country at Onondaga Community College, where he helped produce junior college All-Americans in 1999 and 2001. He also recently has coached in the Empire State Games and

served as Central Region coordinator of men’s track and field for the 2002 Games that were contested in Cortland. Love was an assistant coach for cross country and track and field at SU from 1994 through 1998 and his runners set several school records. The men’s cross country team won the 1995 IC4A University Men’s Team Championship as well as the University of Miami Greentree Invitational and the Western Ontario Invitational. The women’s cross country team also won the Miami Greentree Invitational and earned Academic All-American team honors.

As head cross country coach at Onondaga Community College from 1998 to 2001, Love’s athletes earned two individual conference titles and twice earned junior college All-American honors. As a high school coach at P.V. Moore High School in Central Square, N.Y. from 1984 to 1992, Love’s teams won 16 Onondaga League divisional titles and one Section Three championship. His cross country teams posted a dual meet record of 102-6 over 12 seasons. Love also has coached at East Syracuse- Minoa, Onondaga Central, and West Genesee. Love resides in the Syracuse suburb of Jamesville with his wife, Judy, who is employed by New York State. They are the parents of Jason, 22, and Caitlin, 19, who is a member of the Golden Flyers’ cross country team this fall.

Nazareth Cross Country Assistant Coach Deniece Bell



Assisting Scott Love in Nazareth’s inaugural cross country season is Kitchener, Ontario native Deniece Bell. A 2000 graduate of Syracuse University, Bell was a four-year standout for the track team, earning All-America honors in the 400-meter hurdles in 1998, then competing in the World University Games in 1999. She is the SU recordholder in the 400 hurdles (:56.81) and was the Big East champion in that event in 2000.

At Syracuse, Bell earned a B.S. degree in Child and Family Studies. She also earned a Masters degree in Elementary Education in 2003. While completing her degree, she was an assistant track and field coach at Manlius Pebble Hill High in Jamesville. Bell is also training for a spot on the 2004 Canadian Olympic Team.



About Nazareth College

Nazareth College is a private, co-educational college with a liberal arts and sciences core. Founded in 1924 by the Sisters of St. Joseph, Nazareth has been independent for more than 30 years.

Nazareth’s Athletic Mission and Philosophy

The Nazareth College Athletic Department will strive to empower its student-athletes to grow as people and make a positive impact on society, with life-skills development, mentoring, and leadership opportunities through competitive and cooperative experiences.

The Athletic Department is committed to assisting in the college's mission of educating students with a goal of fostering lifelong commitment to intellectual, ethical and aesthetic values. The Athletic Department will operate under firm institutional control of the college and will always place the health and welfare of the student-athletes, coaches and staff first in decisions regarding the athletics program.

The department will operate under the NCAA Division III philosophy, through which academics are the student’s first priority and sportsmanship, fair play, diversity and ethical conduct are constantly taught and promoted.

Campus Expansion

In 2000, Nazareth contracted to purchase 73 acres of property and buildings adjacent to the current campus from the college's founders, the Sisters of St. Joseph. This opportunity doubles the size of the campus and will enable the college to shape its future in ways previously unimaginable.

A three-phase master plan that will be implemented over the next five to seven years, will integrate the existing campus with the newly acquired property into one seamless and architecturally consistent landscape. New academic programs, including a Master of Arts in Liberal Studies, a four-year Bachelor of Science in Nursing program, and Information Technology have been joined by new athletic programs in cross country, equestrian, softball, and track and field.

Undergraduate enrollment is projected to reach 2,000 students within the next five years.

Ninety-four percent of full-time faculty have received the highest professional degree in their field.

Enrollment

Full-time undergraduate enrollment for the fall of 2003 will be approximately 1,720. That number increases to about 3,100 with the inclusion of part-time and graduate students. There are more than 1,100 students living on campus.

The 2002-03 freshman class had a mean SAT score of 1131. Over 31 percent finished in the top 10 percent of their high school graduating class; 70 percent ranked in the top 25 percent.

Academic Highlights

- During the past 16 years, 24 Nazareth students have won Fulbright grants to carry out research, teach, and study in countries around the world. Few colleges and universities in the nation can match Nazareth's record of preparing students for success in the Fulbright competition – the U.S. government's most prestigious scholarship program.
- Nazareth has a distinguished history of teacher preparation with nearly 1,700 graduates currently teaching in Monroe County classrooms.
- Nazareth features an array of health professions programs, including a Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Music Therapy, Art Therapy, Speech-Language Pathology, and Physical Therapy.
- The Nazareth College Arts Center, which houses the departments of Theatre Arts, Music, and Art, has welcomed more than two million people to performances since it opened in 1967.

Community Service

Ninety-one percent of Nazareth undergraduates participate in community service projects while they are students. In addition, Nazareth offers an on-campus Center for Service Learning, which serves as a resource for students seeking volunteer placements and for faculty who want to incorporate service into the curriculum.

Alumni

Seventy-five percent of Nazareth's 23,000 alumni reside in New York state. Nearly 70 percent are employed in service professions including education, health care, child care, social work, and counseling.

Athletic Highlights

- The average grade-point average of student-athletes for the spring 2003 semester was 3.06.
- A member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Nazareth has 21 intercollegiate teams that compete at the Division III level. Nazareth also competes in the Empire 8 Conference with Alfred, Elmira, Hartwick, Ithaca, RIT, St. John Fisher, and Utica.
- Nazareth's men's lacrosse team won national championships in 1992, 1996, and 1997.
- Nazareth finished 66th in the 2002-03 NACDA (National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics) standings for Division III for its second highest finish ever. The Golden Flyers were represented in NCAA Tournaments in women’s soccer, women’s volleyball, women’s swimming, and men’s lacrosse.
