


Equipped with more than two decades of coaching experience at various levels in the Syracuse area, Scott Love joined the Nazareth athletic department as a full-time staff member in August of 2002.

In 2003, Love served as head coach of the men's and women's cross country teams as well as the

indoor and outdoor track and field teams, all of which were in their first season of intercollegiate competition.

In 2006, Love reaped some reward for his hard work and dedication in building the Nazareth programs as sophomore Nick Stenuf became Nazareth's first track and field All-American in both the indoor and outdoor 800-meter runs.

A graduate of Syracuse University (B.A. English, 1977; M.A. American Literature, 1982), Love coached men's and women's cross country at Onondaga Community College, where he helped produce junior college All-Americans in 1999 and 2001. He also recently has coached in the Empire State Games and served as Central Region coordinator of men's track and field for the 2000 Games that were contested in Cortland.



C O A C H
Scott Love started Nazareth's cross country and track and field programs in 2003.

Love was an assistant coach for cross country and track and field at SU from 1994 through 1998 and his runners set several school records. The men's cross country team won the 1995 IC4A University Men's Team Championship as well as the University of Miami Greentree Invitational and the Western Ontario Invitational. The women's cross country team also won the Miami Greentree Invitational and earned Academic All-American team honors.

As head cross country coach at Onondaga Community College from 1998 to 2001, Coach Love's athletes earned two individual conference titles and twice earned junior college All-American honors.

As a high school coach at P.V. Moore High School in Central Square, NY from 1984 to 1992, Coach Love's teams won 16 Onondaga League divisional titles and one Section Three championship. His cross country teams posted a dual meet record of 102-6 over 12 seasons. Love also has coached at East Syracuse-Minoa, Onondaga Central, and West Genesee.

Love resides in the Syracuse suburb of Jamesville with his wife, Judy, who is employed by New York State. They are the parents of Jason and Caitlin.



JIM ROLINCE Assistant Coach

Nazareth graduate Jim Rolince is back for his third season as a part-time assistant coach for cross country and track and field.

A native of Solvay, NY, Rolince completed his undergraduate degree in Psychology

last year. He's now working on a graduate degree in Education. Before completing his degree at Nazareth, Rolince competed on Nazareth's first cross country team in the fall of 2003 and was a sprinter on the indoor and outdoor track teams in '03-04.

At Solvay High School, Rolince competed in football, basketball, and track and was Section Three pentathlon champion in 2000. In football, he helped Solvay to a Section Three title in 1998 and twice was honored as an Onondaga League all-star.



finished third in the 800-meter run at the NCAA Division III Outdoor championships at Benedictine University in Illinois in May with a time of 1:51.31. . . also set a school record in the 800 by winning the ECAC title at Springfield with a time of 1:50.83. . . also captured the NYSCTC title at St. Lawrence (1:51.73) and was named the Atlantic Region's Track Athlete of the Year by the U.S. Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association. . . named Empire 8 Conference Athlete of the Meet and twice was honored as E8 Athlete of the Week. . . holds outdoor record in the 1,500-meter run (3:58.59) in addition to the 800. . . also part of relay records in the 4 x 400 (3:25.16) and the 4 x 800 (8:06.49). . . enjoyed a successful indoor season, culminating in All-America honors following a sixth-place finish in the 800-meter run (1:53.99) at the NCAA Division III Indoor championships at St. Olaf's in Minnesota. . . finished first at NYSCTC and ECAC championships. . . named Empire 8 Athlete of the Meet after earning first-team E8 all-star honors for the second year in a row. . . holds indoor marks for 400 meters (:51.96), 500 meters (1:10.94) and 1,000 meters (2:31.67) in addition to the 800. . . also part of four relay records. . . played for the Golden Flyers' soccer team in 2005 and contributed one goal and two assists... 2005: transferred to Nazareth from Coastal Carolina and finished eighth in the 800-meter run at the ECAC Outdoor Track and Field Championships. . . earned first-team Empire 8 Conference all-star honors in the 800-meter run for both indoor and outdoor track teams. . . also named team MVP in each. . . Scholastic: a graduate of East Syracuse-Minoa High School, Stenuf was a member of the soccer and track teams. . . finished fourth in the 800-meter run at the state outdoor championships and competed at the high school nationals. . . also won Section Three title in the 800-meter run in 2004. . . won gold medal in the 1,500meter run (3:58.71) at the Empire State Games over the summer.





and was selected team MVP for track... also played one season of tennis... recipient of Brown Scholarship for music.




JESSICA BROWN Junior from Oxford, NY



Nazareth College is a private, co-educational college with a liberal arts and sciences tradition. Founded in 1924 by the Sisters of St. Joseph, Nazareth has been independent for more than 30 years.

Nazareth's athletic mission and philosophy

The Nazareth College Athletic Department will strive to empower its student-athletes to grow as people and make a positive impact on society, with life-skills development, mentoring, and leadership opportunities through competitive and cooperative experiences.

The Athletic Department is committed to assisting in the college's mission of educating students with a goal of fostering lifelong commitment to intellectual, ethical and aesthetic values. The Athletic Department will operate under firm institutional control of the college and will always place the health and welfare of the student-athletes, coaches and staff first in decisions regarding the athletics program.

The department will operate under the NCAA Division III philosophy, through which academics are the student's first priority and sportsmanship, fair play, diversity and ethical conduct are constantly taught and promoted.

Campus expansion

2004 marked the completion of Nazareth's largest capital campaign in history. The college raised \$25 million to support the recent campus expansion through the purchase of 73 acres of adjoining land and buildings. Today's campus features 148 acres and includes the five-story Golisano Academic Center, the 2,200-seat Golden Flyer Stadium, the spacious Elizabeth George and Portka residence halls and a softball diamond.

Students now have twice as many classrooms and computer labs; more undergraduate and graduate programs; opportunities to compete on intercollegiate teams in equestrian, cross country, track and field, men's volleyball, and women's softball; and a choice of living options that includes suites, cafes and free laundry service.

Enrollment

Full-time undergraduate enrollment for the fall of 2007 will be approximately 1,925. That number increases to about 3,200 with the inclusion of part-time and graduate students. There are more than 1,250 students living on campus.

The 2006-07 freshman class had a mean SAT score of 1120. One quarter of incoming freshmen finished in the top 10 percent of their high school graduating class; two-thirds ranked in the top 25 percent.

Seventy-five percent of Nazareth's 23,000 alumni reside in New York state. Nearly 70 percent are employed in service professions including education, health care, child care, social work, and counseling.

- The average grade-point average of student-athletes for the spring 2006 semester was 3.20, a number that includes academic records for more than 400 studentathletes
- A member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Nazareth has 22 intercollegiate teams that compete at the Division III level. Nazareth competes in the Empire 8 Conference with Alfred, Elmira, Hartwick, Ithaca, RIT, St. John Fisher, Stevens Tech, and Utica.
- Nazareth's men's lacrosse team won national championships in 1992, 1996, and 1997.
- Nazareth finished 96th in the NACDA (National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics) standings for Division III in 2005-06. The Golden Flyers were represented in NCAA Tournaments in men's soccer, women's swimming and diving, men's track and field, and women's lacrosse. Nazareth also claimed Empire 8 Conference titles in men's soccer, women's soccer, and women's lacrosse.
