WOMEN'S LACROSSE: NAZARETH SCORES COMEBACK WIN OVER LE MOYNE 11-9

SYRACUSE, NY - Junior attacker Sue Hollister (Syracuse, N.Y./West Genesee) scored four times, including the final two goals of the game to lead Nazareth past Le Moyne 11-9 in women's lacrosse action at Le Moyne College on Wednesday afternoon. The four goals gave Hollister an even 100 for her career with the Golden Flyers, ranking her fourth all-time in that category.

The Golden Flyers (8-1) earned their eighth consecutive win, while the Dolphins dropped to 2-5 on the season. Hollister staked Nazareth to an early 4-1 lead with her first goal 10:35 into the contest. The Dolphins rallied with a pair of goals from freshman Colleen Sperry (Syracuse, N.Y./West Genesee), but Maya Lambiase (Rochester, N.Y./Irondequoit) made it a two-goal game with her second tally of the contest midway through the first half.

Le Moyne closed out the first half on a four-goal run. Sophomore Meghan Haven (Liverpool, N.Y./Liverpool) and Sperry scored goals to knot the contest at five and Amanda Daniels (Painted Post, N.Y./Corning East) chipped in two goals to earn the Dolphins a 7-5 halftime edge. Daniels netted her third goal of the game two minutes into the second half, but Nazareth countered with six of the final seven goals. After Allison Roberts (Rochester, N.Y./Irondequoit) pulled the Golden Flyers even with nearly 17 minutes remaining, sophomore Alexis O'Brien (Manlius, N.Y./Fayetteville-Manlius) gave Le Moyne its final lead five minutes later. Lambiase recorded her third goal on the afternoon to tie the contest at nine. Hollister rifled home the game-winner with 6:37 to play and tacked on an insurance goal with four minutes remaining. Nazareth goalkeeper Teryn Wineburg (Auburn, N.Y./Auburn) stopped 11 shots in the cage for the win, while Le Moyne's Brandy Payne (Geneva, N.Y./Geneva) made 16 saves in the loss.
