MIDDLEBURY ADVANCES TO SEMIFINALS FOR SEVENTH STRAIGHT YEAR

MIDDLEBURY, Vt. - Middlebury went on a 9-0 second half run on its way to a 16-7 win over Nazareth in the NCAA Quarterfinals. The Panthers advance to take on Williams in the semifinals on Saturday at 2:00 at the College of New Jersey. The host school will meet Salisbury State in the other semifinal at 11:30 a.m.

Middlebury jumped out to a 3-1 lead with a pair of goals from Betsy Wheeler in the first 5:33 of the game.
